## IMPORTANT INFORMATION Meade County Clerk Office

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet is implementing a new vehicle titling and registration system at the beginning of 2024. Over 40 years of data from the current system will be transferred to the new system beginning the first week of January. The time to transfer this data is measured in days and weeks, not in minutes and hours.

The tentative date for Meade County to go live on this new system is January 10<sup>th</sup>.

## The main things to remember:

- There is going to be a necessary disruption to motor vehicle transactions to begin 2024 and every effort is being made to minimize the disruption.
- Although December 29<sup>th</sup> is a State Holiday, the Meade County Clerk Office will be open to give Meade County residents as much time to renew 2023 registrations and vehicles needing to be transferred before the year end. The office will be closed January 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> to observe the Holiday. The office will remain closed to the public for any motor vehicle transactions until the rollout of the new system.
- 2024 renewals will not be able to be processed until the new system is live in 2024.
- The Meade County Clerk office will begin on the new system on January 10<sup>th</sup> to process back logged mail and dealer work and to get familiarized with the new system before opening back to the public on Friday, January 12<sup>th</sup> with normal business hours 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
